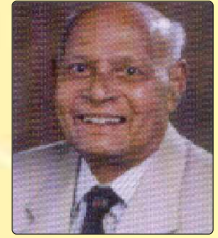

29th Continuing Orthopaedic Education Course COE - 2011, Patna

This course was started in 1983 by Late Prof. Dr. B. Mukhopadhaya and continues to be one of the most popular courses held in India.



Late Prof. B. Mukhopadhaya is one of the forefathers of Indian Orthopaedic Surgery and was largely responsible for introducing innovative and modern orthopaedic surgery in the Indian scenario.

A dedicated teacher, he continued his passion for teaching even after his retirement and was responsible for initiating this annual continuing Orthopaedic Education programme. The first course was held in Patna in 1983.

At the time Orthopaedic Surgeons had very little access for updating their knowledge after having completed their post graduation. Very few courses were held in India and the internet revolution was still a distant dream. Foreign travel was expensive and beyond the means of most Orthopaedic surgeons.

Dr. Mukhopadhaya in his travels realized this acute need for continuing medical education. He spoke to some of his close friends and colleagues and embarked on the idea of the COE courses.

The honours and awards which he received were many and include the prestigious Hunterian lecturer of the Royal College of Surgeons of England, B. C. Roy award, Padma Bhushan award and the Life Time Achievement Award of the Indian Orthopaedic Association.

About the course this year...2011

The first two days of the course will consist of lectures, case discussions, debates and interactive sessions. On the first day the main focus will be on trauma around knee and ankle while on second day, the course will mainly cover on arthroscopy, arthroplasty and cold orthopaedics.

The workshop will be on 3rd day i.e 18.9. 2011 which will be limited to 150 participants on first come first serve basis.

Delegates will be required to register additionally for the workshop but will also have to register for the main course.

Workshop is divided into two groups.

Group 1 include Trauma and Group 2 include Non Trauma (TKR, Arthroscopy & HTO)

Those who are interested in getting registered for workshop can choose either of the 2 groups.

Preference of group has to be given at time of registration. In case one of the group has been filled – the candidate may be shifted to second group.

75 members can get registered in each group.

One cannot get registered for both groups or different subgroups of two different groups.
